Strategy Overview

The investment advisor has developed a proprietary investing system that utilizes the fundamental stock-selection methods outlined by great investors, such as Ben Graham, Warren Buffett, Martin Zweig, John Neff and many others. These computerized fundamental models are used as the foundation for the fund's stock-selection approach. All US-traded stocks meeting specific liquidity requirements are scored across more than twenty unique investment models, but only the top-scoring individual stocks, ranked according to the manager's best-performing risk-adjusted "guru"-based models, will be held within the portfolio.

Why Invest in VALX?

- I. Investment approach utilizes the fundamental stock selection strategies of Wall Street legends.
- II. Strategic blending of models should help reduce variability over time and has the potential to generate superior investor returns.
- III. Disciplined, rules-based approach removes emotions and biases that often times adversely affect investors' performance.
- IV. Active ETF structure offers real-time transparency in portfolio holding, intraday pricing, flexible trading and low expense ratio.

Risk Controls & Disciplined Management Rules

- Approximately 100 stocks representing a variety of capitalizations providing for adequate exposure and diversification;
- 10 systematic proprietary "guru"-based models (over 20 distinct models run by the firm) to ensure strategy diversification across the portfolio;
- Sector and position limits to avoid overconcentration in one particular area of the market or one stock;
- Real-time and dynamic stop-loss criteria are utilized in an attempt to avoid major company-specific catastrophic events;
- Staggered and set rebalancing dates allow our top-rated stocks to continuously be added to the portfolio during the year;
- Liquidity requirements to ensure portfolio positions are of sufficient size and liquidity.

*Active share can be defined as the measure of the percentage of stock holdings in a manager's portfolio that differ from the benchmark index. The measure offers an intuitive way to answer the question: "How active is your portfolio manager?" Active share is measured on a scale from 0% to 100%. Index funds have less than 20% active share as they closely mirror their benchmarks with no appreciable difference in holdings. A fund with an active share above 80% is considered to be highly actively managed. The Russell 2000 index measures the performance of the small-cap segment of the U.S. equity universe, while the S&P 500 is considered the index most widely followed by investors and is comprised of the 500 largest companies that trade on US exchanges.
